DESIGN FOR THE USER

WORDPLEX/1 is designed for the secretary. It makes typing easier—not more complicated. Just switch it on, set the margin, type and enjoy. As you type, your copy appears on the display screen; and if you make a mistake, simply backspace and re-type. The display screen shows the characters you want, where and how you want them. Use it like a typewriter, and it will do everything a good typewriter will do. But, that's just the start...WORDPLEX/1 does much more.

WORD PROCESSING

Insert a word or a complete paragraph, a character or a sentence, a page or a chapter; delete, change, repeat ... all with the touch of a key.

Move a paragraph; make the margins wider or narrower; center the text; even justify the right margin. Statistical typing is no longer a boring and time consuming task for the secretary using the WORDPLEX/1 decimal column alignment feature. The WORDPLEX/1 computer allows you to see a wide page on your display screen. This moving "window" pans left and right, and scrolls up and down permitting easy viewing of any portion of a 66 line by 132 character-wide page.

DOCUMENT ASSEMBLY

Two hundred pages of text are available for you to recall from the WORDPLEX/1 memory. There is no longer a need to re-type a standard paragraph each and every time it occurs. Simply specify the page, paragraph, or phrase you need and it will be automatically inserted where you want it. And WORDPLEX/1 does it instantly. It takes less than one second to reach any information in the WORDPLEX/1 memory. There is no reading through a long cassette tape to reach a selection you need. With WORDPLEX/1 you can assemble a perfect original in seconds.

COMMUNICATIONS

WORDPLEX/1 is a stand-alone unit, convenient and easy to use in a small office, and its potential is enormous. Telephone lines can be used to connect it with other WORDPLEX systems anywhere in the world. Think of the flexibility this provides. You can create a perfect original five thousand miles away from your keyboard. WORDPLEX/1 can also be connected, through telephone lines, to computers or other office machines to create exciting networks of capability.





DISPLAY SCREEN

The WORDPLEX/1 display screen shows your text as you create, assemble, or edit - but before it is printed. It displays a page as wide or as long as is needed, and at all times you control the position of a "window" which is 80 characters wide and 24 lines long. From your keyboard, you can pan right or left to see the rest of an extra wide page; or scroll up or down to scan an extra long page or review the information you have already typed.

The bottom two lines are reserved for information such as: the position of margins, tabs, line number, page number, and column position, as well as other data...all designed to help you.





KEYBOARD

WORDPLEX/1 starts with a standard typewriter keyboard. You will feel comfortable with it at once. The cursor (or indicator) control keys are grouped logically. The tabs are where you would expect to find them. The control and edit keys, which are unique to WORDPLEX, are not vague or mysterious. Each key has a plain language description of its function right on it. Any secretary can utilize the system just by reading the key tops.

Typical of the WORDPLEX design philosophy, and for your extra convenience we have connected our keyboard to the display screen with a flexible cord. You can move it, adjust it for right hand or left hand convenience, turn it on an angle or adjust the distance to the screen to suit you and your needs best.

HIGH SPEED PRINTER

The documents created on the WORDPLEX/1 high speed printer are indistinguishable from those made on a high quality office typewriter. The printer has all the features of a fine quality typewriter. There is a wide choice of type fonts. Cartridge loaded ribbons are available. Our printer operates at five hundred and forty words a minute. Its true speed, however, is even faster since the print head alternately types left to right and then right to left. An average page takes less than a minute to print and because the printer and the display screen function independently, you can print one document while you are composing the next.

Like the rest of the system, the WORDPLEX/1 printer is designed for the modern office environment. It is quiet, unobtrusive and elegantly styled to fit your decor.



FLEXIBLE DISK STORAGE

The reasons we have chosen flexible disks for the storage element of WORDPLEX/1 are many. Flexible disks are easy to handle and load. They are reliable and durable. Permanently sealed in a protective envelope, the magnetic surface is not handled at any time. They are also fast. The reading head advances directly to the information selected - recall takes less than a second. Flexible disks are efficient. Each eight-inch disk can store over a hundred full pages of text, and they can be mailed worldwide at normal postage rates.

With WORDPLEX/1 you have the convenience of two disk drives. No longer is it difficult to merge text from two separate files. Address files and form letters, proposals and standard material, specifications and contract clauses, or any combination unique to your office needs can be assembled at the touch of a key.






