Depending on the pitch, it prints in executive letter quality mode at burst speeds of 100 to 171 cps or in draft mode at burst speeds of 160 to 274 cps. This gives you the flexibility needed to meet a broad spectrum of application requirements.

*Support for a number of systems.* IBM Quietwriter III Printer is the perfect counterpart for IBM Personal System/2™ models, most IBM Personal Computers—as well as many non-IBM PCs with a compatible interface.

What's more, most of today's popular PC software programs—both IBM and non-IBM developed—are supported!

*The advantages of resistive ribbon printing.* The key to the IBM Quietwriter III Printer's silence and quality is IBM's innovative Resistive Ribbon Thermal Transfer technology, a non impact printing process that eliminates the use of noisy hammers and printwheels.

The result: executive letter quality printing with virtually silent operation. You can use

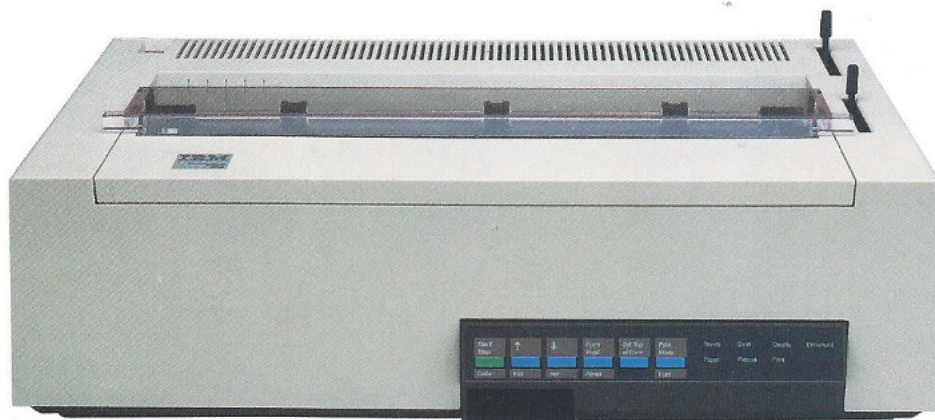

At the same time, it can significantly improve the working environment in areas where several printers are used simultaneously.

*Transforming ideas into images.* If you're looking for a printer with high-resolution (240 x 240 dots per square inch) APA graphics, the IBM Quietwriter III Printer has just what you need. It helps you produce dynamic charts, diagrams and drawings to make your reports and transparencies more distinctive.

*Plenty of ways to put it on paper.* From customized reports and other text documents to eye-pleasing, effective graphics—even a combination of the two—the IBM Quietwriter III Printer gives you plenty of ways to put your ideas on paper.

You can choose from three printing modes, each with its own range of speeds. Depending on pitch, the quality mode can print your most important documents and letters at burst speeds of 100 to 171 cps. For quality printing on many hard-to-print papers and under difficult environmental conditions, you can choose the enhanced mode. It prints at burst speeds of 80 to 136 cps. And for handling everyday utility jobs, you can select the draft mode, which offers near letter quality printing at burst speeds of 160 to 274 cps.

**Versatile paper handling options.** IBM Quietwriter III Printer offers three convenient automated paper handling options: a Single Drawer Sheet Feed, a Dual Drawer Sheet Feed with an Envelope Option, and a bidirectional Pinwheel Forms Feed.

Depending on the option you select, you can obtain such features as sequenced page output, adjustable paper-width support, and simplified paper loading.

**An array of type styles.** For added versatility, the IBM Quietwriter III Printer lets you use up to eight online type styles. Four popular fonts are built into the printer, ready for instant use. By simply inserting an optional plug-in cartridge, you can add up to four more fonts. And the download font feature offers more fonts on diskettes. The result is greater convenience and more interesting printed documents.

#### Highlights

Here's a quick look at what the IBM Quietwriter III Printer has to offer.

**Resistive ribbon** keeps the printing noise level down to 45 dBA by using heat to transfer images.

**Three printing modes** range in burst speeds from 100 to 171 cps for executive letter quality printing, 160 to 274 cps in draft mode for near letter quality printing at draft speeds, and 80 to 136 cps in enhanced mode for hard-to-print papers and printing under difficult environmental conditions.

**Font flexibility** means you can use up to eight online fonts offering a wide variety of type styles—including some with scientific, engineering and multilingual characters—from embedded fonts, plug-in cartridges or downloadable fonts.

**240 x 240 dots per square inch APA graphics** help produce quality text and sharp visuals that lend an added dimension to business reports.

**Dual Drawer Sheet Feed** offers automatic feeding of a variety of paper sizes and as many as 150 sheets of letter-head or stationery can be fed from either paper drawer.

**Envelope Option** (for the Dual Drawer Sheet Feed) automatically feeds approximately 50 envelopes.

**Control panel** lights up to indicate when the ribbon needs to be changed, when more paper is needed, and more.

**Ribbon cassettes** change in a snap—just pop out the old and pop in another.
